VARANASI

"Older than history, older than tradition, older even than legend, And looks twice as old as all of them put together " - Mark Twain

Varanasi is often referred to as "the city of temples", "the holy city of India", "the religious capital of India", "the city of lights", "the city of learning", and "the oldest living city on earth."

The name Varanasi originates from the names of the two rivers: Varuna, still flowing in Varanasi, and Asi, a small stream near Assi Ghat.

Hindus believe that one who is graced to die on the land of Varanasi would attain salvation and freedom from the cycle of birth and re-birth. Abode of Lord Shiva and Parvati, the origins of Varanasi are yet unknown. Ganges in Varanasi is believed to have the power to wash away the sins of mortals.

Knowledge, philosophy, culture, devotion to Gods, Indian art and craft have all flourished here for centuries. Also a pilgrimage place for Jains, Varanasi is believed to be the birthplace of Parsvanath, the twenty-third Tirthankar.

Vaishnavism and Shaivism have co-existed in Varanasi harmoniously. Mrs. Annie Besant chose Varanasi as the home for her 'Theosophical Society' and Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya, to institute 'Benares Hindu University, the

largest University in Asia. Ayurveda is said to be originated at Varanasi and is believed to be the basis of modern medical sciences such as Plastic surgery, Cataract and Calculus operations. Maharshi Patanjali, the preceptor of Ayurveda and Yoga, was also affiliated with Varanasi, the holy city. Varanasi is also famous for its trade and commerce, especially for the finest silks and gold and silver brocades, since the early days.



Varanasi has also been a great center of

learning for ages. Varanasi is associated with promotion of spiritualism, mysticism, Sanskrit, yoga and Hindi language and honored authors such as the ever-famous novelist Prem Chand and Tulsi Das, the famous saint-poet who wrote Ram Charit Manas. Aptly called as the cultural capital of India, Varanasi has provided the right platform for all cultural activities to flourish. Many exponents of dance and music have come from Varanasi. Bharat Ratna Ravi Shankar, the internationally renowned Sitar maestro and Bharat Ratna Ustad Bismillah Khan, (the famous Shehnai maestro) are all sons of the blessed city or have lived here for major part of their lives.

Places you visit in Varanasi:

GHATS IN VARANASI: are an integral compliment to the concept of divinity represented in physical, metaphysical and supernatural elements. All the ghats are locations on "the divine cosmic road", indicative of "its manifest transcendental dimension". Varanasi has at least 84 ghats. The extensive stretches of ghats enhance the river front with a multitude of shrines, temples and palaces built "tier on tier above the water's edge".

What you can't miss on GHATS?

Morning boat ride on the Ganges across the ghats is a popular visitor attraction.

The Dashashwamedh Ghat is the main and probably the oldest ghat of Varansi located on the Ganges, close to the Kashi Vishwanath Temple A group of priests perform "Ganga Aarti" daily in the evening at this ghat as a dedication to Shiva, Ganga, Surya (Sun), Agni (Fire), and the whole universe.



KASHI VISHWANATH TEMPLE AND GYANVAPI MOSQUE: Dedicated to Lord Shiva, the temple has earned the name of Golden Temple due to the gold plating done using one ton of gold donated by Maharaja Ranjit Singh on its 15.5-m high spire. Invaders destroyed the original temple and Rani Ahilyabai of Indore rebuilt it in 1776. Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb destroyed the



Vishvanath temple to replace it with the Gaynvapi Mosque. However, one can still see the remnants of the temple in the intricate and fine artwork of the western wall of the mosque. Today, the Kashi Vishwanath Temple and the Gyanvapi mosque lie adjacent to each other.

DURGA TEMPLE: The 8th century Durga temple is built in Nagara Style and is one of the most important temples of the city. The 'shikhara' of the temple consists of several small spires layered one on top of the other.

BHARAT MATA TEMPLE: Dedicated to Mother India, is situated in Mahatma Gandhi Kashi Vidyapeeth. It was built by Babu Shiv Prasad Gupt and inaugurated by Mahatma Gandhi in 1936. The statue marble of Mother India shows undivided India with mountains, plains and oceans in exact proportions.

TULSI MANAS TEMPLE: Dedicated to Lord Rama, this temple is said to be built on the site where Goswami Tulsidas wrote the epic 'Ramacharitmanas'.

BANARAS HINDU UNIVERSITY: The Banaras Hindu University or BHU is an internationally reputed University and is situated in Varanasi. The great nationalist leader, Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya, founded the Banaras Hindu University in the year 1916. Over a period of time, it has developed into one of the greatest centers of learning in India. The BHU has produced many great freedom fighters and Nation builders. It has immensely contributed to the progress of the nation through a large number of renowned scholars, artists and scientists.

BHARAT KALA BHAVAN: Bharat Kala Bhavan, located inside the BHU campus, is an art and architecture museum and houses a vast collection of paintings, Hindu and Buddhist sculptures and other materials of archeological importance. The Bharat Kala Bhavan was established in the year 1920 A.D.

SARNATH: Sarnath, about 10 km from the holy city of Varanasi, is the place where Buddha chose to deliver his first sermon. The celebrated Mantra, 'Buddham Sharanam Gachhami', owes its origin to Sarnath. On the day before his death Buddha included Sarnath along with Lumbini, Bodh Gaya and Kushinagar as the four places he thought to be sacred to his followers.



SARNATH MUSEUM: Sarnath has yielded a rich

collection of sculptures, artifacts and edifices comprising numerous Buddha and Bodhisattva images and other ancient remains. To house all the findings and excavations at Sarnath, the Archaeological Survey of India established a site Museum at Sarnath. Finest specimens of Buddhist art and other important remains have been housed at the museum. The main attraction of the Sarnath Archaeological Museum is the superb Ashokan Pillar. It has four back-to-back lions, which has been adopted as the National symbol of India. Below this are representations of a lion, an elephant, horse and the bull.

RAMNAGAR FORT: The Ramnagar fort lies about 14 km. from Varanasi and is situated on the opposite bank of river Ganga. It is the ancestral home of the Maharaja of Banaras, Maharaja Balwant Singh built this fort-palace in the eighteenth century. The Ramnagar fort has a temple and a museum within the grounds displaying the Royal collection which includes vintage Cars, Royal palkies, an armoury of swords and old guns, ivory work and antique clocks and the temple is dedicated to Ved Vyasa, who wrote Mahabharata.

RULES & REGULATIONS

(BOYS & GIRLS)

- 1. CBSE Inter-School Badminton Tournament will be conducted according to the latest and revised rules of Badminton Association of Indian (BAI) with modifications wherever applicable.
- 2. Every school can send one team comprising of maximum four players, in Under 14, Under 17 & Under 19 yrs separately in Boys & Girls category.
- 3. All the participants must carry their valid age proof certificate and school/CBSE Board Identity-card.
- 4. All the matches must be played on indoor courts with proper lighting arrangements.
- 5. In Team Championship, the order of play shall be: Singles Doubles Singles.
- 6. All the matches that are played on "league basis" shall be of best of one game of 31 points with change of side at 15 points. The player that reaches first at 31 points, wins the match.
- 7. All the matches that are played on "knock-out basis" shall be of best of three games of 15 points each, & a match is won with the difference of 02 points. In case, of 14 all; the game shall continue; however, the player that reaches first at 19 points wins the match.
- At Zone Level all the matches will be played strictly on knock-out basis. In case the numbers of teams in a
 particular age category are less, the championship in that category may be organized on league cum knock
 out basis.
- 9. No change shall be permitted in the composition of team from Zonal Level to National Level.
- 10. The school Organizing Zone level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate in National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
- 11. National Championship will be conducted on League cum knock-out basis for which all the teams will be divided into different pools.
- 12. At National level, one day of the Championship shall be dedicated exclusively to the Individual Championship.
- 13. At National level: All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way that by and large no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP (BOYS & GIRLS) ONLY AT NATIONAL LEVEL

- 1. In addition to the Team Championship, separate Individual Championship shall also be played at National level on knock out basis.
- 2. Each team reaching in the Nationals shall nominate one player who shall play singles title in each Age Category separately for boys & girls.
- 3. In each age group, as per BAI ranking list, the top ten ranking players shall be eligible to play directly at National level in "Individual Championship". However, if any player, ranking in top ten, has played at respective Cluster level Individual Championship, and has lost, shall no more be eligible to participate in Individual championship at National level.

MIXED DOUBLES CHAMPIONSHIPS - ONLY AT NATIONAL LEVEL

- 1. In addition to the Team Championship, a separate Mixed Doubles Championship shall also beplayed at National level on knock out basis.
- 2. Each team reaching in the Nationals shall nominate one player from its team (other than the onewho has already been nominated to play Individual Championship) to play in Mixed DoublesChampionship in each Age Category.
- 3. In all the Age Categories; the nominated Girls & Boys would be paired by lot.

PARTICIPATION DETAILS AND BOARDING AND LODGING

- 1. All teams shall be accompanied by a **Teacher/Coach/Manager** designated by the participating School Principal.
- 2. No Team shall be accompanied by any parent.
- 3. In case of girls participants, accompanying officials must be a female.
- 4. The officials accompanying the teams shall have a valid identity card issued by their school Principal.
- 5. Proof of the payment of CBSE Annual Sports Fee for the year 2019 -20.
- 6. The teams must print **and carry the players ID cards** generated after the registration of the students. While reporting the venue the teams shall also carry the print out of the filled in online entry Performa.
- 7. **No extra person** shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the playfield along with the teams.
- 8. Lodging will be provided in the school premises separately for boys and girls in the classrooms. Accompanying Teacher/Coach/Managers will also stay with the contingent members only. Schools are free to book their own hotels as per their convenience if they do not want to stay in the school. In case teams are staying in the hotels travel to and fro to the school will have to be managed by them on their own. The school will not be able to provide transport for pickup and drop on a daily basis.
- 9. The participating schools shall remit with the organizing school **Rs.350/- per head** per day against boarding and fooding. No part payment will be accepted against the same. All schools have to pickup coupons for the entire duration of the tournament i.e. from 3rd to 7th of December' 19. The school will make arrangements against payment for evening refreshments and dinner on the 2nd Dec' 19.
- 10. Security Deposit of Rs. 3000/- (Three thousand only) will also be made by each team at the time of registration which is refundable.
- 11. No costly items or jewellery etc. are to be brought to the campus during championship as the school will not be responsible for the loss of any personal belongings.
- 12. In the opening and closing ceremony, participants must wear either school uniform or tracksuit. All the teams shall compete in the inter-school tournament in their respective playing uniform with the prescribed colour of their school and numbered.
- 13. Please carry mild winter clothing as the weather will be cold.


